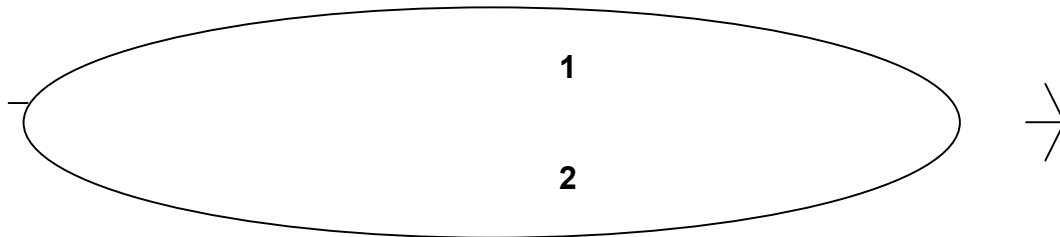
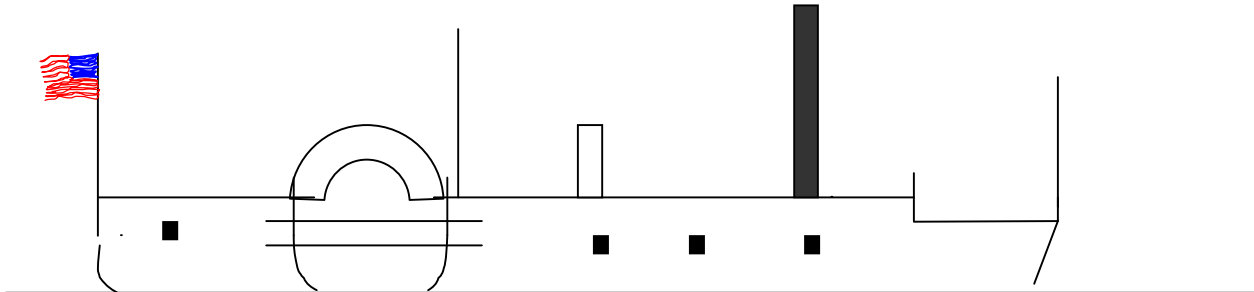


# Ironclad Control Sheet

Turn around 210 yd circle – estimate.

## Batteries

1. Two or three 8" smoothbores, makes one Heavy Bat. Pen G at range 5.
2. Two or three 8" smoothbores, makes one Heavy Bat. Pen G at range 5.

The broadside guns are assumed to be in wide ports and can bear up to 30° either side of the beam.

A single 32 pdr SB was mounted fd. Counts as a long ranged pepperer, bearing anywhere afore the beam. Another was mounted astern (tho this may have been a later addition), bearing anywhere astern. In skirmish games only, these can each be replaced with 1/6<sup>th</sup> of a battery, non penetrating guns.

## Miscellaneous

About 177' 7" x 36' 10". Depth of hold 6', so prob boat draught. Unarmoured. I think no ram. Acquired 1861 for the US Army's Western Gunboat Flotilla. Commissioned that Sept with officers provided by the Navy. Saw a lot of action. Sold out of the service, 1865. See second sheet for later armament. 14 PF.
